Billy Boiling Guidelines

- Each heat will have 4 or 5 competitors
- Each competitor is allocated a piece of ground with about 1 metre between each square
- Contestants are given a tomahawk, a 7 inch square pine block of wood, 1 box of matches and a flattened cardboard drink carton
- Each contestant will be timed using a stop watch
- There is no 'final'. The winner will be the best time over the course of the weekend.
- Competitors can enter more than once but first time entries get priority
- Competitors must sign this disclaimer before competing
- Only persons over 16 years and over can enter
- 600 ml of water is measured into each billy. A small amount of detergent is added to the water (as this froths to the top)

Rules for Contestants

1. On the 'GO' signal stop watches start and the competitors cut the pine using the tomahawk to build the fire as they see fit
2. Competitors can use as many of the matches as wanted however the matchbox cannot be thrown onto the fire to aid the fire
3. The billy can be placed on the fire at anytime
4. The flattened cardboard drink carton can be used to fan the fire but cannot be burned
5. More pine from their block of wood can be added at anytime
6. You cannot use or make a lid for the billy
7. If the billy is knocked over and if any water is spilled the contestant is disqualified
8. The billy is deemed to be boiling when the water boils and rises to the top of the billy (aided by the addition of the detergent this determines a clear winner and stops the argument of when water is actually deemed to be boiling)
9. The judges decision is final
