



HONEY COMPETITION SCHEDULE

Key information	
Entry fee	\$2 per entry
Applications for entry	Entries only accepted on morning of the Field day. Go to the Tocal chapel to complete and submit the entry form.
Closing of entry	All entries must be lodged by 9am on the morning of the Field day. Entries after this time will not be accepted.
Judging	Conducted between 9am and 1pm. Judging is closed to exhibitors and the general public. A condition of entry is that exhibitors must accept the judges' decision as final.
Results	Announced at the end of the Field day program.
Prizes	Certificates will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place exhibitors along with a prize to the value of 1st \$50, 2nd \$35 and 3rd \$20 .

CLASS SELECTION

The honey competition has three classes; light, medium and dark liquid honey. Refer to the table below for the Pfund reading for each Class. Tocal will not move Exhibits that are entered into incorrect Classes.

Class	Colour	Pfund reading
1	Light	16-34
2	Medium	35-59
3	Dark	60-120

ORIGIN OF EXHIBIT

All entries must be of Australian Origin, 100% Australian honey produced and packaged in Australia.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Exhibitors are permitted to enter a maximum two (2) entries per Class each which must be obtained from a different honey batch. Entries must have been produced between 1 September 2018 and 30 September 2019. Entries must be presented for Judging in a clean unlabelled standard 500g glass round jar, with a white plastic or white metal lid.
